public static void Main() {
string str = "One if by land, two if by sea.";
char[] seps = { ' ', '.', ',' };

// Split the string into parts.
string[] parts = str.Split(seps);
Console.WriteLine("Pieces from split: ");
for(int i=0; i < parts.Length; i++)
Console.WriteLine(parts[i]); // Now, join the parts. string
whole = String.Join(" | ", parts); Console.WriteLine("Result
