

# Linux Sound Card HDMI problems

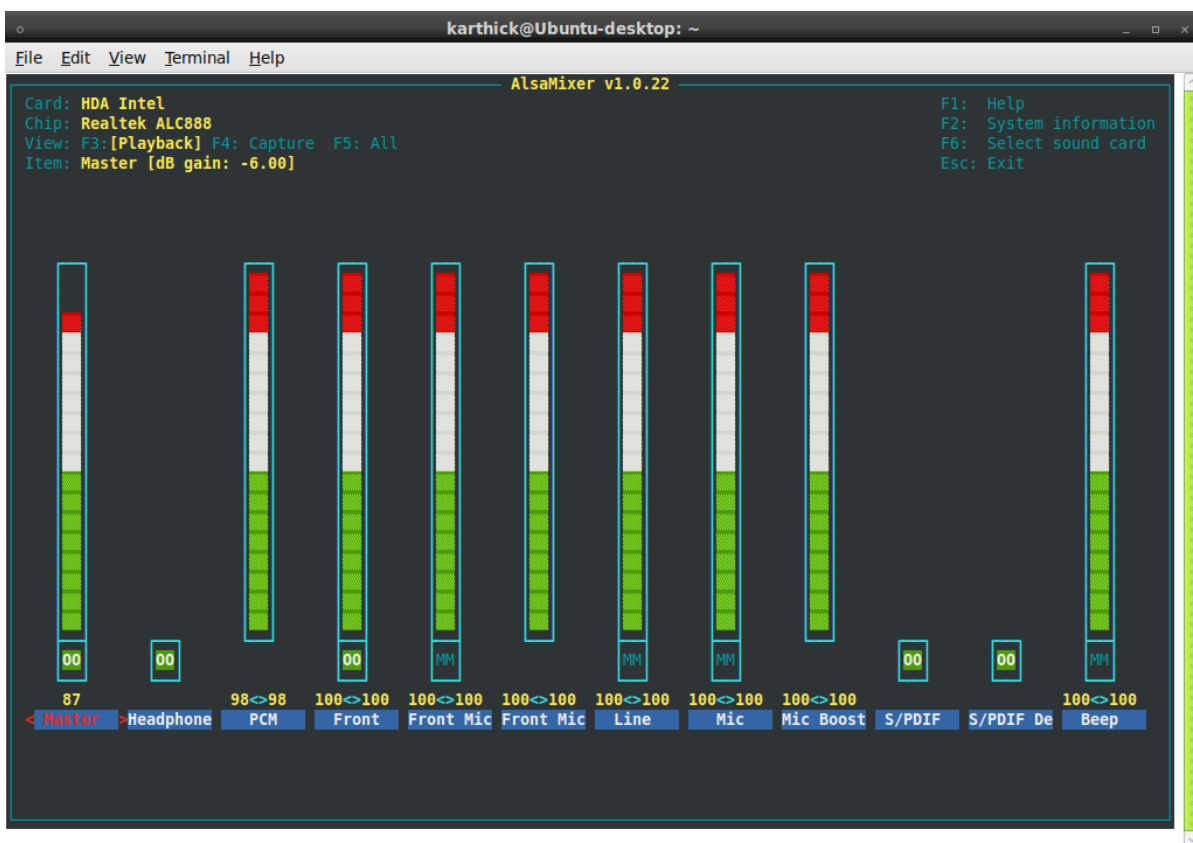
1. How can I change the default audio device from command line?
